On Thursday, May 23, Saint Mary's University of Minnesota will welcome Dr. Artur Schwartz for **"Five Reasons Why It's Hard to be a Character-Centered Leader."** Dr. Arthur Schwartz, the former Senior Scholar at the United States Air Force Academy, will explain why so many leaders resist placing character at the core of their leadership philosophy. Arthur will also share evidence-based
